

2013 Hangtown Classic FAQ's

1. When does the track get turned over to DDNMC?

Track turnover & event preparations begin Wednesday May 1st.

2. Will Prairie City MX be open prior to the Hangtown event for practice?

No, please visit the PC MX website, www.prairiecitymx.com.

3. How do I buy tickets?

Call **1-800 HANGTOWN** or go online to www.hangtownmx.com.

4. How do I speak to a live person about a Hangtown event question?

Go online to hangtownmx.com and click on "Contact Us" to leave your information with telephone number.

5. When can I arrive to camp & what is the cost?

Enter using the Main Gate, the park opens to campers on Wednesday at Noon in the Main Staging Area only and the fee is \$60 for the weekend. Additional vehicle fee \$30, park only in marked spaces.

6. What gate do I enter into for the event?

The Main gate is for participants & campers, use Gate #4 for Will Call and access to Lot C; On Sat. Gate #4 is for Pro's, Vendors, Will Call, ADA parking & event workers; Sat. after 10am for access to Lots A & C; Gate #5 only open Saturday for Lots C & D.

7. Where do I go for ADA access?

Enter into either the Main Gate or Gate #4 and check-in at "Will Call" or advise the parking attendants you need seating & parking for ADA access; your vehicle should have the appropriate placard or plate visible and you will be directed to the covered ADA seating on Concession Hill.

8. Where do I find "Will Call" to pick-up my tickets?

The "Will Call" tent is located outside the Track Pits entrance inside the 4x4 Obstacle Course off Pit Road and Gate #4 Event Road, follow signs.

9. I want to ship something to your park for the event, where can it be shipped to?

Prairie City SVRA address is 13300 White Rock Rd. Rancho Cordova, CA. 95742; Note: all deliveries must have a person on site to sign for it; CA State Parks staff will not accept or sign for any deliveries. You will need to contact the Dirt Diggers staff via their website to coordinate any special assistance.

10. I am participating as an amateur on Thurs. or Fri., what special equipment must I have on my motorcycle.

All motorcycles must meet DDNMC rules and CA Sound Law for motorcycles not to exceed 96 dBA; or they will be disqualified.
