

COTTONWOOD AND CIRCLE CANYON CAMPGROUNDS FIRE CLOSURE

1. Effective September 15, 2013, due to two years of exceptional drought and impending seasonal Santa Ana winds leading to extreme fire danger, all forms of fire with the exception of gas powered stoves will be banned in the following two areas of Hungry Valley State Vehicular Recreation Area: Cottonwood Campground and Circle Canyon Campground. These two campgrounds are designated as such because of the close proximity of a large number of fire rings to moderate/dense vegetation. Visitors have the opportunity to utilize the other campgrounds within the park in order to enjoy a campfire in our provided metal rings.
2. This order shall remain in effect until significant precipitation is received.
3. Exceptions to this order will only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Hungry Valley District, PO Box 1360, Lebec, CA 93243-1360.
4. Nothing in this order shall affect any existing contract or property rights.
5. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provision of law.
